RE: **Camp Woodie Doe Tournament Sponsored by Cabela's**

Camp Woodie will host the second annual Doe Tournament Sponsored by **Cabela's** September 18-19, 2010. The entry fee for the tournament is \$300 per person. The person who shoots the heaviest doe will receive 30% of all \$300 entry fees. The second heaviest Doe will receive 15% of all entry fees. The third heaviest doe will receive 5% of all entry fees. Fourth place will receive a new Remington 270 rifle. Fifth place will receive a \$300 entry fee into next year's tournament. The landowner of the property where the heaviest doe is shot will receive 10% of the entry fees and Camp Woodie will receive 40%. If we have 100 entries first prize for the heaviest doe would be \$9,000. The owner of the property where the heaviest doe was shot would receive \$3,000 and Camp Woodie would receive \$12,000. Camp Woodie will not be eligible to win the landowner prize. If the heaviest doe is shot at Camp Woodie the landowner prize will be given to the owner of the private property where the second heaviest doe was shot.

There will be daily Calcutta's of \$50 each for the heaviest doe and the heaviest two does. Cash awards on each Calcutta will be 40% to first place, 20% to second place, 10% to third place, 15% to the landowner where the first place doe or does were shot and 15% to Camp Woodie. SCWA will provide lodging for up to 50 hunters at Camp Woodie on a first entered first served basis. SCWA will also provide dinner and cocktails for all hunters on Saturday night along with a lunch and Awards presentation at noon on Sunday. The agenda for the event is as follows:

5:00 a.m. – Wake up with coffee and donuts
5:30 a.m. – Travel to deer stands
10:00 a.m. – Morning hunt ends with Breakfast served at Camp Woodie all morning
9:00 a.m. – Noon – Weigh In at Camp Woodie Pavilion
Noon - Cash Awards

Camp Woodie Doe Tournament Rules

1. All South Carolina Department of Natural Resources Deer hunting regulations must be followed.
2. All hunters must have a valid South Carolina hunting license unless they are less than 16 years of age.
3. A hunter must be registered in the tournament by 4:00 p.m. on September 18, 2010 to enter a doe.
4. When weighing in a doe the registered hunter will sign a sworn affidavit stating that he or she is the person who shot the doe.
5. Registered hunters can only weigh in does that they killed during the tournament hunting hours of Saturday, September 18 from 4:00 p.m. to 1 hour after sunset and on Sunday, September 19 from one hour before sunrise to 10:00 a.m.
6. All deer must be properly tagged prior to being weighed in.
7. Hunters are allowed to shoot and weigh in no more than two does on each hunting day.
8. Youth hunters can hunt in the same stand with a registered adult hunter. Only one gun is allowed per stand. The youth or adult can shoot the deer.
9. Hunters are responsible for their deer. If a hunter wishes to donate the deer to Camp Woodie they must make a \$75 donation to cover the cost of processing. A deer processor will be on site to process deer.
10. All deer will be weighed at Camp Woodie on a digital scale to the nearest ounce. Weights will be recorded on a weigh in sheet listing the time of weigh in, hunters name and property where the deer was shot. Weigh in sheets will be signed by the hunter and weigh master.
11. In the case of a tie the doe weighed in first will win the tie.
12. Landowners who wish to host registered hunters who do not have a place to hunt must notify SCWA by noon on September 18.
13. A landowner or deer leaseholder does not need to be entered in the tournament to qualify for the landowner/deer leaseholder prize.
14. No hunting in high fenced areas is allowed.
15. Still hunting only.
16. No antlered deer are allowed to be shot at Camp Woodie. There will be a \$250 fine for any antlered deer shot at Camp Woodie. Individual landowners will set their own rules on shooting antlered deer. However, the shooting of bucks is discouraged since a conservation goal of the doe tournament is to help control local doe populations.
17. Any complaints will be referred to the tournament committee. The decisions of the committee will be final.
